What is God's Plan?

Even before you were saved, God knew you and had a perfect and detailed plan for your life. Find out what God has in mind for you because all His plans are good.

God Provided for All to be Saved

From the beginning God's plan was that all [sinners] would come to Him through belief in the truth [Jesus] and sanctified [made holy] by the Spirit to become more like Jesus (Rom 8:28). The will of God is that all who believe in Jesus [the Son] will have everlasting life and will be raised up the last day. (John 6:40)

God calls us into His Ministry

"God into the world... rings into every believer's ears". Proclaiming the gospel is every Christian's commission. Jesus appoints His friends to "go and bear fruit" - lasting fruit (John 15:16).

We are God's fellow workers 1 Corinthians 3:9

God has a Specific Plan for You

When you were yet unborn, God had a written record of your days as in a "Book of Remembrance" in which all your days are fashioned (Psalm 139:16; Jer 1:5). His thoughts [plans] are totally different than ours (Isa 55:8,9) but if we thirst [want] for what God has, He gives us freely of the fountain of the water of life (Rev 21:6). Commit yourself completely to His plan!

God and His Plans are Good

You cannot imagine what God has prepared for you (1 Cor 2:9) and whatever you circumstances, God will supply all your needs (Phil 4:19). If you obey God it will be well with you (Deut 5:29) because all things work together for good for those who love Him (Rom 8:28). Endure so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise (Heb 10:36).

Proclaim = make known Do what suits God (His will) James 4:15 to be evident in our daily speech and plans. Specific = detailed

On judgement day the "books" are opened, Revelation 20:12,15 Not our own plans, see Isaiah 30:1; Micah 4:12 **Commit** = pledge or align
